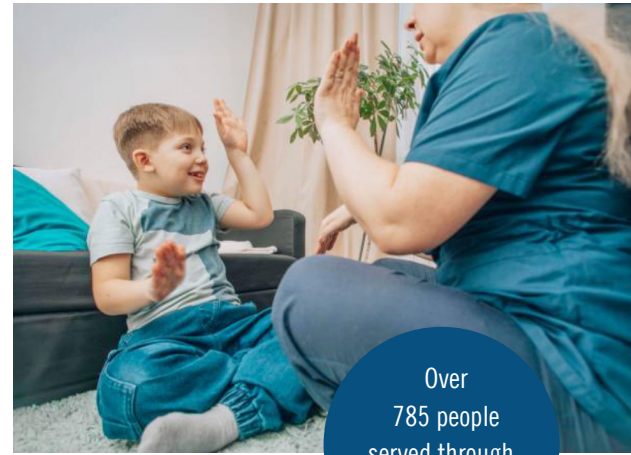

PROGRAMS: STATISTICS AND OUTCOMES

MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING

- Provided services to 242 people through substance abuse counseling and to 543 people (approximately 241 adults and 127 children/adolescents, and 175 family members of clients) through mental health counseling.
- Provided 2,808 units (1,883 hours group therapy and 925 hours individual/family therapy) of outpatient substance abuse counseling and 4,165 units of outpatient mental health counseling.
- 88% of mental health clients completing the follow-up survey reported developing healthier coping skills; 81% report learning to express their feelings more appropriately.
- 71% of substance abuse treatment clients completing the follow-up survey reported having healthier coping skills. 100% reported decreased or discontinued substance use.
- 88% of mental health and 86% of substance abuse clients reported that treatment at LCCC was meeting their needs.
- 52% of substance abuse treatment clients and 50% of mental health counseling clients reported living below 150% of the national poverty level.

CASE MANAGEMENT & PEER SUPPORT

- LCCC Case Management Recovery Team provided 997 units/hours of individual case management and support and 598 units of substance abuse peer recovery support sessions and phone calls.
- 2,103 units of service hours were provided through Engagement Group sessions.
- 128 individuals attended engagement groups, 81 of which had at some point also attended therapy groups and individual counseling. Another 58 individuals attended Engagement Groups only, usually people who had previously completed treatment at LCCC. The three weekly engagement groups each had an average attendance of 8 individuals, with some groups having up to 15.
- 95 new Recovery-Oriented Systems of Care (ROSC) intakes were completed, of which 81 (85%) of individuals moved from ROSC services to treatment services during the fiscal year. This is the third year in a row that we have had 80+% of people move from support to treatment, which is the goal of the Engagement Groups.
- 60% of substance abuse treatment and case management clients reported living below 150% of the national poverty level.

PARISH MINISTRY

- 13 couples completed *A Lasting Promise Marriage Prep*, a seminar which teaches couples to communicate what they want out of their relationships and how to resolve conflict.
- LCCC partners with the Livingston Deanery Catholic Council on Aging to facilitate the Lenten Retreat, Annual Picnic, Senior Appreciation Mass & Luncheon, and the Thanksgiving Celebration for older adults, hosting several hundred people annually.
- Through *Walking with Moms in Need* ministries, Catholic parishes and communities 'walk in the shoes' of local pregnant and parenting women to connect them with the help they need.

SENIOR SERVICES

Community Liaison

- Provided 1,409 units of service to 1,443 clients.
- Community Liaisons provided 727 individuals with explanation of benefit comparisons, eligibility and assistance with enrollment in the following programs; Medicare Part A and B, Low Income Subsidy, Medicare Part D, Extra Help, Medicare Advantage, Medigap, Medicaid.
- 100% of seniors served reported they have support and services in place to live safely in their home.
- 40% reported incomes below 150% of the national poverty level.

Volunteer Caregiver Program

- 100% of seniors served reported they have the services necessary to permit them to live safely in their homes.
- 100% of volunteers reported program satisfaction.
- The program served 88 seniors and provided 2,060 units of service.
- 60% of seniors reported incomes below 150% of the national poverty level.
- 783 individual transports were provided for a total of 1,835 hours and 28,497 miles of transportation.
- 212 hours of friendly visits.
- 40 active volunteers.

Prevention of Elder Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation

- 570 individuals attended events on Elder Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation.
- 133 of the individuals attended events at the local senior centers.
- 4.5 hours were provided educating individuals on Elder Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation.
- 95% reported an increased understanding of elder abuse risk factors and signs, including financial abuse, and how to obtain assistance.
- 100% of respondents reported they understand and agree that any type of elder abuse is a crime after attending a Community and Elder Justice presentation.

Home Injury Control and Chore Programs

- 100% of participants reported that the staff understood their needs and a decrease in stress after services were provided.
- 100% of participants reported feeling safer in their homes.
- The Home Injury Control Program served 50 participants and installed 178 pieces of home safety equipment.
- The Chore Program served 68 participants and provided 364 units of service.

PROGRAMS: STATISTICS AND OUTCOMES

BE OUR GUEST ADULT DAY SERVICE (BOGADS)

- BOGADS provided 8,985 units of service to 48 participants and their families during this year.
- 85 individuals participated in the Caregiver Support Groups.
- 95% of caregivers both reported a positive social change in their loved ones after attending BOGADS, and that participation directly contributes to their loved being able to remain at home.
- 100% of caregivers reported decreased stress and that the cost-sharing fee schedule is important for their ability to provide care to their loved one.

2024 CHRISTMAS BLESSING PROJECT

For nearly 30 years, Livingston County Catholic Charities has been providing food boxes, cleaning supplies, hygiene items, paper products, and a Christmas gift to seniors across Livingston County. Between donations received, volunteer hours worked, and seniors served, this was a historic year for the Christmas Blessings Project. This year, with the support of the community, we served 364 seniors, up from 311 served last year. Over 200 dedicated volunteers donated over 900 hours of their time to this year's project. This project is truly a community endeavor!

SPECIAL MINISTRIES

- 107 adults with disabilities were served through a variety of recreational, social, spiritual and educational events.
- 6,552 hours of organized programming were provided.
- 100 volunteers provided 545 hours of service.
- 33 caregivers and their parents were served through the Special Ministries support group.

SUBSTANCE USE PREVENTION

- In conjunction with the Livingston County Sheriff's Office, Livingston County Community Alliance (LCCA) conducted alcohol compliance checks throughout the County. 94% of alcohol retailers and restaurants did not sell alcohol to minors.
- LCCA, in partnership with Unite to Face Addictions Michigan (UFAM) and The Amber Reineck House, brought in the "Breaking the Silence" speaking tour to County middle and high schools and the community. National as well as local speakers shared their stories with youth and community members to raise awareness about the harm of youth substance use.
- LCCA's Livingston County Youth-Led Advisory Board (Y-LAB) held their fifth Youth-Led Summit. 75 youth from the 5 high school districts came together to learn and build leadership skills. The students identified changes they wanted in their schools, and created action plans to make those changes over the school year. The Youth-Led Summit was made possible by the Sunrise Rotary Midnight in the Tropics Grant!
- LCCA's Y-LAB held their 4th Youth Art Voice, displaying 50 youth art pieces from all Livingston County school districts. Youth Art Voice encourages youth to explore and communicate what mental health means from their unique viewpoints and experiences. They displayed their art at Howell Opera House and Pinckney Art in the Park.
- LCCA had 45 volunteers who provided 607 volunteer hours.

SPECIAL GRANT FUNDS AT WORK

Livingston County Catholic Charities (LCCC) is deeply grateful for the outstanding grant support received over the past year. These generous contributions from local and national foundations have empowered LCCC to expand programming, enhance outreach efforts, and strengthen services across all areas of our mission, from behavioral health and senior services to disability programming and community-wide holiday initiatives.

The Livingston Sunrise Rotary awarded a \$2,500 grant to fund our annual Christmas Blessings program, along with an incredible \$25,000 Midnight in the Tropics grant that supports our Substance Abuse Prevention Program.

Our work in behavioral health counseling was fortified through major contributions, including \$25,000 from the Raskob Foundation, \$25,000 from the A.A. Van Elslander Foundation, and support from the CPPS Heritage Mission Fund. Two \$40,000 grants from the Pulte Family Charitable Foundation benefited both behavioral health services and our Special Ministries program. We were also awarded \$50,000 from the Community Mental Health Partnership of Southeast Michigan to renovate our behavioral health offices and upgrade essential technology.

LCCC's senior outreach and support efforts expanded significantly thanks to a second-year \$75,000 grant from the Michigan Health Endowment Fund to support rural senior outreach. Additionally, a \$75,000 joint grant from the Community Foundation for Southeast Michigan was awarded to both Livingston County and Washtenaw Catholic Charities to launch a collaborative outreach initiative serving seniors in bordering rural communities. We also received \$25,000 from the Towsley Foundation in support of our Be Our Guest Adult Day Service.

Additional community-driven generosity includes a \$10,000 grant from the PNC Foundation supporting our Community Liaison Program, a \$1,000 contribution from the Livingston Consortium on Aging for Christmas Blessings, and continued support from the Community Foundation of Livingston County, reinforcing our ability to meet essential needs across our programs.

These investments allow us to respond compassionately and effectively to our community's most urgent needs. We are proud to partner with organizations that share our vision of a healthier, stronger Livingston County.



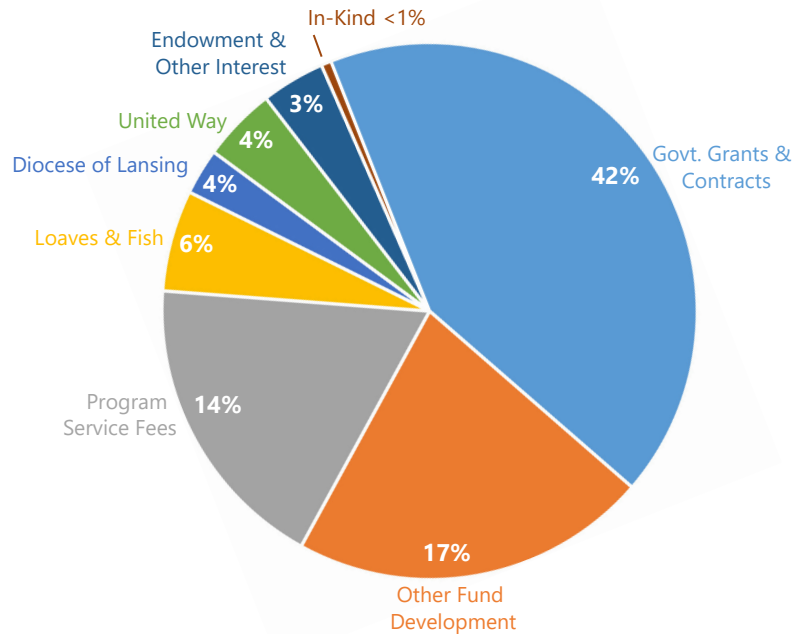

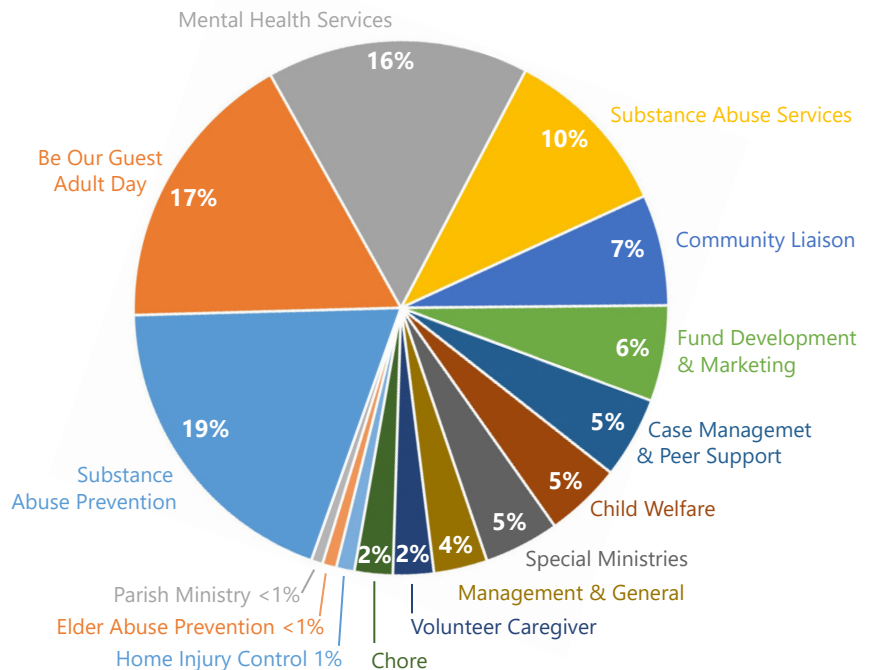
